5. Novice Western Pleasure. (walk, jog) Novice is anyone who has not yet won three blue ribbons.
6. Jr. Western Pleasure Championship.
7. Open Western Pleasure Championship.
8. Clover Leaf Barrels
9. Key Hole Race
10. Musical Stalls. Riders are to ride the rail to music, when the music stops riders are to get into a “stall” a designated area, and each time a “stall” and rider are eliminated.
11. Trail Pleasure Racking Stake. E/W (walk, trail pleasure rack)
12. Juvenile Gaited Go As You Please .E/W (walk, go as you please)
13. Light Shod Walking Horse 2 Gait. (flat walk, running walk) E/W
14. Open Gaited Go As You Please. E/W (walk, go as you please)
15. Light Shod Walking Horse 3 Gait. (flat walk, running walk and lope or canter) E/W
16. Novice Gaited 2 Gait. (walk, pleasure gait) E/W
17. Pursuit. (Riders are to space out on the rail, and gait as fast as they can without breaking into a canter or lope and each time a rider is passed they are out until there is one rider)
18. Juvenile Gaited Go As You Please Championship.
19. Open Light Shod 2 Gait Championship.
20. Open Gaited Go As You Please Championship.
